Organization

- Students will be given time in class to work on their homework.

Math Help Services

We will be using the Interactive Workbook this year. All MHS documents, assignments, notes and video lessons are available through student's math help services account. Please check your account on a daily basis.

Assignments

- Assignments must be handed to me personally, on the due date that was given.
- Should your child be absent, their work must be handed in to me personally, on the next school day that they are present (even if there is no math class that day).

Be prepared

Students must bring all the materials they will need at the beginning of class. Students are to show up to class on time.

Be respectful
